Rock Crystal - fake diamond or genuine healer

Water-clear crystalline quartz, "fake diamond", or rock crystal looks like ice. The ancients considered this mineral to be ice, frozen as much that the frost gave it a magical power. The name itself in Greek means "ice". And, although the legends of magical ice are in the past, the rock crystal magical properties are used by knowledgeable people to this day.

This mineral is a mascot-gemstone of 1 lunar day, a short period in which we can lay the foundation and set the mood for the whole next month. This means that the greatest strength rock crystal acquires immediately after the New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Rock crystal in the history of different countries

Beauty, refinement, powerful energy and unusual properties of water-clear quartz have brought the fame and demand to this gemstone in almost all cultures of the world. In Ancient Greece gods and rulers drank wine from crystal cups. Rock crystal magical properties were already known in the ancient world. So, myths say that in the temple of Demeter there was a magic crystal mirror, predicting the future. In addition, the ancient Greeks believed that the prayer uttered with this mineral in hands would be surely heard by the gods.

Maya Indians used rock crystal to make props for their rituals – skillfully faceted skulls. Historians are still puzzling over how the ancient Aztecs managed to handle the stone so accurately. One of the skulls is now stored in the British Museum.

Balls from this mineral symbolized power and adorned the scepters of the rulers of Scotland and Byzantium. The ancient Romans used the thermal properties of this gemstone to escape the summer heat. Japanese poetically called it "the frozen breath of a dragon". In Egypt people made from it magical talismans for luck. From time immemorial, rock crystal was also popular in Russia. Peter I had a samovar cut from a single piece of this stone.

Rock crystal in lithotherapy

People learned about the rock crystal healing properties long before the word "lithotherapy" appeared in the dictionary. This gemstone has:

- Disinfectant property, due to which our ancestors used rock crystal to make cups. Any drink in such a container is clean, disinfected and stores useful substances.
- The ability to maintain the temperature balance. The Roman patricians used rock crystal pendants to survive the stuffiness and heat, but the stone can give not only a coolness in the summer, but a warmth in the frosty winter.

- Energetics, which contributes to the concentration of attention, improving memory and productivity of thinking. Knights Templar especially appreciated these characteristic. They implanted the crystals directly under their skin.
- The ability to gather all negative things, including physical pain and ailments.

You can improve rock crystal healing properties by charging the crystal with sunlight on a 1 lunar day. In addition, from time to time, you should clear this mineral from all the negativity that it gathered from the surrounding space. For this, wash the stone regularly with running cool water.

Rock crystal energetics and its impact on humans

As already mentioned, this mineral gathers all the negative from the space in which it locates, and from its owner. Therefore, with the help of rock crystal, it is good to clean the dwelling from time to time. The more spacious your house and the more negative energy in it, the more quartz crystals you need. It is very useful to conduct such a procedure after a long illness of someone from the dwellers. You will surely have a healthy sleep in the cleaned space.

The second magic feature of rock crystal is its ability to work with information. The fact is that this mineral is able to accumulate information better than other gemstones. That's why clairvoyants and mediums from all corners of the world used crystal balls to obtain valuable information – messages from deceased and divine omens.

Thus, rock crystal magical properties should be used by:

- spiritual seekers with the aim of developing intuition and the gift of foresight;
- students and scientists during the preparation for exams and researches;
- physically and mentally ill people for the quick recovery;
- housewives to cleanse the energies of the house;
- for a gift. If you want to give someone your positive emotions and feelings, charge a rock crystal them with on a 1 lunar day, and this mineral will definitely bring your mood to its new owner.

Jadeite - "lumbar stone" of virtue and peace

Jadeite is a relative of nephrite. Most often it is green, but there are also white and pink gemstones. Interestingly, the very name of this mineral confirms jadeite magical properties. It occurs from the Spanish word combination "piedra de ijada", which in translation means "lumbar stone". In times of America's conquest, people knew that this stone is capable of curing kidney diseases.

Jadeite is a mascot-gemstone of the 2 lunar day, the period of the first active steps in the implementation of plans for the coming month. This means that jadeite gets the greatest power on the second day after New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Jadeite in the history of different countries

Ancient Indians widely used jadeite in everyday life. They made household utensils, tools, house decoration from it. Over time, this gemstone has become one of the most popular materials for making Indian amulets and decorating their temples. In addition, this mineral tied with the cult of the Sun and used to conduct its rituals.

Between New Zealand inhabitants, jadeite was worth more than gold. In the Chinese and Japanese empires people believed that this stone gives health and longevity. They made jewelry, furniture, and even pillows from it! Each wealthy resident wore a ring with jadeite.

Jadeite in lithotherapy

Jadeite healing properties have been used for a long time in different cultures of the world. This mineral is able to:

- 1. Positively influence the human reproductive function. Jadeite cures sexual impotence and infertility, facilitates pregnancy, promotes successful and rapid childbirth.
- 2. Adjust blood pressure, relieve heart disease. The most effective for this purpose is pink jadeite for hypertensive patients.
- 3. Strengthen the medicinal properties of drugs for kidney disease. It is interesting that jadeite itself cannot heal kidneys, but in tandem with medications helps to recover quickly and without complications.
- 4. Strengthen immunity, stabilize all processes in the body. This is possible due to the energy balance stabilization, which entails the improvement of work of all the organs.

To strengthen jadeite healing properties, you need to heat the stone. It is good to use this mineral during bath procedures. The body is relaxed and ready to take the beneficial substances

released by the heated stone. In addition, you can heal pets with jadeite, placing stones in your pet's sleeping place.

Jadeite energetics and its impact on humans

Esoterics and magicians consider jadeite the most faithful stone. Defending its master from the negative, it can save his life and fall to pieces. In general, jadeite magical properties can be divided into three groups.

At first, it is a peacemaker stone, a mineral of virtue. It calms anger and aggression in its owner and does not allow him to do bad things. Jadeite smooths conflicts and creates a peaceful atmosphere. Even such tough disagreements, which often happen between parents and children, this mineral is able to calm down, to establish the connection of generations.

Secondly, it's the stone of a happy married life. Jadeite retains feelings in a couple for years, protects the house from jealousy and scandals. In ancient times, the girl, accepting the offer to marry a guy, gave him a pebble of jadeite. The day before the wedding, he gave her the jewelry made of this pebble.

Thirdly, this gemstone is the patron of businessmen. After all, jadeite faithfully serves not only its master but also its business. From time immemorial, farmers used jadeite to obtain a luxurious harvest, and wandering merchants – for the successful conclusion of deals. And even in gambling, this stone promises luck to its owner.

Jaspilite - "gastric stone", which increases energy

Jaspilite is a very ancient gemstone, which started forming since the Precambrian times. Our distant ancestors did not reach such depths, so, mankind's acquaintance with jaspilite occurred recently – thanks to the development of the industry. This striped mineral, at first sight, reminded people of a jasper, that is why it was named "jasper stone".

Jaspilite magical properties are unique, mainly due to all those millennia spent by the stone in the bowels of the earth. This mineral is able to "multiply human energetics" and everything that already exists in us. Therefore, jaspilite is very useful for strong and purposeful people. And for the weak person, it can be even harmful.

Since the 3 lunar day gives all people the will, concentration, and strength, jaspilite is a talisman-gemstone of this period of the lunar cycle. This means that the ancient mineral has the greatest strength on the third day after New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Jaspilite healing properties tie with its ability to change the composition of human blood and have a beneficial effect on the gastrointestinal tract. It is also called the "gastric stone". Lithotherapists use this mineral for:

- improvement of appetite and metabolic processes, treatment the diseases of stomach, pancreas, intestines;
- purification of blood, increasing the amount of oxygen in it and the level of hemoglobin, improving coagulability for faster healing of wounds;
- purification of vessels from slags, improvement of blood circulation, normalization of arterial pressure;
- excretion of kidney stones;
- treatment of prostate adenoma, restoration of male potency, reduction of menstrual pain of women.

Jaspilite energetics and its impact on humans

Jaspilite magical properties are all about its special ability to multiply human energetics. At the same time, under the word "energetics" this gemstone means internal strength, a strong will, determination, perseverance, concentration on the goal. To the person with the appropriate traits jaspilite will give:

- protection from any negative influences from the outside, from spoiling and evil eye to envious persons and competitors;
- increased stress and failure resistance, firmness;
- great success in business, especially in long-term and large-scale projects.

Before working with a stone, it is desirable to clean your own bio field from the negative. The easiest way is to take a shower and ask water to wash away all alien energy from you, all the negative things that have settled on you during your contacts with other people.

Amazonite - women's patron

The green-blue mineral amazonite looks like turquoise. There are two versions of the origin of its name: in honor of the Amazon River and thanks to the legendary tribes of women warriors. Amazonite magical properties confirm the second version – this gemstone is known as the patron of the fair sex.

Amazonite is a talisman of the 4 lunar day. This is a heyday of the family ties power, the acquisition of secret knowledge. It means that this mineral has the greatest strength on the fourth day after New Moon. All the rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Amazonite in the history of different countries

Despite its name, amazonite was a popular gemstone on different continents and in different cultures. Jewelry from this mineral were popular among the American Indians, and in ancient Egypt. Thus, in the tomb of Tutankhamun were stored many necklaces, amulets, and rings from the amazonite.

And, of course, the habitats of the legendary Amazons – Scythian mounds – delighted archaeologists with a variety of jewelry from this stone.

Amazonite in lithotherapy

Amazonite healing properties were popular among the people in the Middle Ages. The experience of many generations indicates that this mineral:

- Can rejuvenate the body skin, joints, hair, and teeth. Accelerates the cell regeneration, cleans the body of toxins;
- Heals arthritis, rheumatism and osteochondrosis. Amazonite powder eliminates tumors;
- Treats varicose veins, cleans vessels, breaks local fat deposits by the massage with amazonite balls;
- Promotes the normalization of the thyroid gland and the endocrine system as a whole;
- Relieves a migraine, protects from sunstroke;
- Alleviates epileptic seizures.

Amazonite magical properties are extremely useful for women. In this case, it is not necessary to have the militant character of the Amazon in order to obtain the strength of this mineral. It gives harmony, peace, and stability to women of all ages and types of temperament. So, amazonite is useful for:

- Strengthening of family ties, friendly and partner relations, relations between parents and children, conjugal love;
- Inspiring women for everyday housework, the prompt resolution of domestic problems, creating an atmosphere of peace and comfort in the home;
- Improving devotion and courage in a person or people who are in touch with it.

Chalcedony - the stone of energy balance

Chalcedony is a mineral that combines several subspecies of gemstones. Here are chrysoprase, carnelian, agate, onyx, sardonyx... Each of them has its own distinctive features, but there is much in common.

Its name is chalcedony due to the ancient city on the coast of the Sea of Marmara – Chalcedon. This transparent, layered stone was popular in the East from old times. So, Mongols believed that chalcedony gives joy and chases sorrow. And in the Hindu scriptures, blue stones were considered the embodiment of the divine consciousness. Modern esotericists and astrologers talk about the ability of this mineral to restore the energy balance – remove excess emotions, add lacking strength, and so on.

Chalcedony is a gemstone-talisman of 5 lunar day, the time of decisive actions and concentration on the goal. This means that chalcedony has the greatest power in the fifth day after New Moon, and all the rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

The rules for choosing and working with chalcedony

It is necessary to admit: this mineral is wayward and not so simple in circulation. To use chalcedony magical properties for your happiness, you need to follow several important rules:

Give preference to stones with bright, juicy color, transparent, not cloudy. Such characteristics indicate the strength and powerful energy of chalcedony, which it will be able to share with you.

Note that chalcedony of different types and colors have several different abilities and vectors of influence. So, the red stone inclines its owner to frankness and active actions; orange one patronizes the artists; green – teaches patience; blue – sharpens intuition and makes thinking more productive.

Fractures and cracks in chalcedony are places of accumulation and storage of information that a stone receives from the surrounding space. The more of them, the more knowledge this mineral will be able to store. Therefore, for rituals associated with the transfer and receipt of any knowledge, it is worth choosing a pebble with a lot of "voids" inside.

Do not keep chalcedony on your body for too long. If the stone has already helped you to normalize your mental state, get out of depression and get rid of fears, take it off for a little while. Otherwise, the process will start in the opposite direction. It is a balance stone, and it will not tolerate a long emotional upsurge of the owner just like lingering apathy.

Chalcedony in lithotherapy

Chalcedony healing properties come from its craving to restore the balance of energies. This stone:

- Stabilizes blood pressure. Particularly useful for hypotonic, whose pressure is often below normal;
- Normalizes heart rhythm, relieves arrhythmia;
- Gives a healthy sleep, helps to fall asleep quickly and wake up with a feeling of vivacity;
- Gives strength and energy during weakness after illness or psychosomatic weakness due to depression.

Chalcedony energetics and its impact on humans

It is interesting that this mineral is able not only to cheer up its owner and give him confidence but also enhances his attractiveness for others. Chalcedony magical properties are especially useful to artists, lawyers, speakers and lonely hearts "in active search". So, this stone:

- Attracts to its owner the attention of the opposite sex;
- Gives the talent of eloquence, if you hold the pebble under the tongue for a while. You will speak more convincingly, and the brain will find better arguments faster;
- Relieves anguish, fear, melancholy, aggression, energizes to move towards the goals.

Marble - the stone of the goddess of love and creativity

Marble is a stone, common in construction since ancient times, and its unusual coloring managed to sneak into the all spheres of modern life. Its name translates from Greek as "shining stone". In nature, light marbles are the most common. However, there are also red, green, brown and black specimens.

People learned about marble magical properties several millennia ago. The ancient Greeks considered this mineral to be the stone of the goddess of love, Aphrodite. They erected her temples solely from marble. The Romans believed that marble is able to protect from evil spirits. They often tile their houses with marble slabs. Indians add one more hue to this palette of magical properties. In their opinion, marble not only scares off evil spirits but also attracts the good ones.

Marble is a stone-talisman of 6 lunar day, the period when we learn to surrender to the Higher Powers and read the Destiny's signs. This means that marble has the greatest power in the sixth day after New Moon, and all the rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

The rules for working with marble

Esotericists associate stones with elements and energies. So, transparent minerals are saturated with male energy "yang" and refer to the elements of fire and air. Opaque ones have female energy "yin" and refer to the earth and water.

So, marble is the "yin" stone, connected with water. Especially useful it is for water Zodiac signs (Pisces, Scorpio, Cancer) and women. Nevertheless, this mineral can also serve all other people. It quickly tunes "to the wave" of any owner.

In order to keep neatness and useful properties of the marble amulet for a long time, it is necessary to clean it regularly with a fabric and polish with a piece of suede.

Marble in lithotherapy

Marble magical properties are various and useful for a variety of ailments and problems. Lithotherapists use this mineral to heal:

Marble magical properties, associated with its ancient patroness – Aphrodite, will help the lonely hearts find their love and permanently preserve it. Marble strengthens fidelity and dedication of spouses, helps to create a strong and happy family.

Citrine - the patron of abundance, intelligence, and communications

Citrine owes its name to its own coloring. From the Latin "citrus" translates as lemon yellow. This mineral is very warm and sunny, there are crystals from pale-lemon to amber-honey hues. The trimmed citrine looks noble and expensive, so people call it "golden crystal". It is a stone of material prosperity and abundance, patronizing public figures engaged in the transfer of knowledge and networking.

Citrine is a mascot-gemstone of the 7 lunar day, period, when the power of words and knowledge transmission reaches its maximum. This means that citrine gets the greatest power on the 7th day after New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Citrine in the history of different countries

Since ancient times citrine was a gemstone of privileged – nobles, orators, philosophers. Thus, in Ancient Rome only high-ranking people could wear jewelry with this mineral. In Medieval Europe, the nobility used the seal rings with citrine to seal important letters. Ladies wore rings with "golden crystal" to get rid of nightmares and headaches.

The inhabitants of the East were familiar with the citrine magical properties too. In the Feng Shui system, this mineral is able to purify the space from the negative and to attract abundance and wealth. Experts spread crystals along the dark corners of the dwelling to dispel the negative, which accumulates there.

Citrine in lithotherapy

Nowadays, citrine magical properties are available not only to the rich and the authorities. Lithotherapists use solar mineral crystals to:

- Improve the eyesight
- Reduce allergic reactions;
- Treat gastrointestinal diseases;
- Get rid of problems in the genitourinary system;
- Regulate the work of the endocrine system and most of the glands;
- Quickly remove toxins;
- Accelerate the processes of cell regeneration;
- Improve brain work, prevent the diseases associated with violations of its work.

Interesting that citrine is able to work with chakras, cleaning them and contributing to the restoration of energy exchange between the centers. It has a special impact on Manipura – the chakra in the solar plexus, which is related to the ability of a person to take material wealth, prosper and rejoice.

Citrine makes its owner a charming, eloquent, stubborn and determined person; a magnet for social love and cash flow.

In addition, citrine instills self-confidence in a person, relieves fatigue, and saves from burnout. This stone is necessary for vulnerable and sensitive people. It cools the ardor of emotions, brings pragmatism and common sense to any situation.

If you are familiar with the basic characteristics of planets in astrology, you have already guessed that the patron of the citrine is Mercury. Accordingly, this mineral is the best mascot for Gemini, Solar and Lunar.

Chrysolite – the golden stone of dragon

In Greek, chrysolite is the "golden stone", and according to the ancient Mongol legend it is the "stone of dragon". It tells us about a brave warrior who decided to erect a fortress in an old steppe. But, no matter how hard the builders tried, the fortress collapsed time after time. It turned out that a long time ago the djinns buried the stolen treasures in this place. These treasures rightfully belong to the dragons. To build a fortress, the warrior must return them to the owners.

The army dug up the whole steppe, and when, finally, they found mysterious treasure, a fiery whirlwind carried it away. And people, following the whirlwind, began to find beautiful gems on the ground. It was a chrysolite, "the stone of dragon".

Chrysolite is a mascot-gemstone of the 8 lunar day, a period of rebirth from the ashes, second chance, and new beginning. This means that chrysolite gets the greatest power on the 8th day after New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Chrysolite in the history of different countries

Chrysolite magical properties were known to people in Greece and Mongolia from ancient times. So, the Greeks believed that this stone brings peace, and the Mongols – masculinity and courage. In Medieval Europe chrysolite used to regain male strength, cure impotence. And in India it was called a talisman of lovers, who retained feelings forever.

Chrysolite in lithotherapy

Chrysolite magical properties are widely used in lithotherapy to this day. So, this mineral heals:

- Diseases of the stomach and kidneys, if applied to a sore spot;
- Sexual impotence, diseases of the genitourinary system in men;
- Eye diseases glaucoma, cataracts, restore visual acuity;
- Insomnia, nightmares;
- Stuttering caused by stress or severe fright;
- Unreasonable anxiety.

Rules of work with chrysolite

Like any transparent gem, chrysolite is the "Yan" stone, saturated with male energy. Accordingly, it will be more useful for men.

In this case, it is very important to be the first and only owner of the stone. Chrysolite is a very faithful mineral, it is tuned to the biofield of its owner and does not want to serve anyone else. They say that falling into the "second hands", the crystal of chrysolite grows dull and crack.

In addition, chrysolite craves the attention of its owner. Wear it often, take it to your hands. Remember that this stone is fragile enough, protect it from sharp objects, impacts, temperature changes.

Chrysolite magical properties have an interesting feature. This mineral is able to harmonize the work of the brain's hemispheres, giving the owner what he lacks. For example, thanks to chrysolite, skeptics become more intuitive, and creative individuals learn pragmatism. In addition, chrysolite:

- Gives its owner courage and confidence;
- Promotes the multiplication of wealth, if you put a pebble near your money savings;
- Saves from envy your own and others;
- Improves memory;
- Helps lovers to achieve mutual understanding.

Alexandrite - the rarest, "imperial" stone

Alexandrite is one of the five rarest gemstones on our planet. Its unique feature is the ability to change its color. This stone was discovered by people quite recently, in 1832, on the territory of the Russian Empire. Hence its name – in honor of Tsar Alexander II, who got the crystal as a gift from the archeologist for the 16th anniversary.

The life of the monarch is not easy, full of difficulties and temptations. People tried to kill Tsar Alexander several times, and there is an opinion that alexandrite protected him. However, in the end, death overtook the ruler. And the stone has gained immense popularity among the authorities as the stone of the emperor.

Alexandrite is a mascot-gemstone of the 9 lunar day, a tense period of overcoming our fears and temptations, manifestations of the strength of spirit and courage. This means that alexandrite gets the greatest power on the 9th day after New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Alexandrite in the history of different countries

Alexandrite magical properties have always been associated with its ability to help the owner to overcome life's difficulties. People believed that when the stone change color, it predicts fate. Yellow and red color promises danger and trouble. However, if a person can survive, she will gain prosperity and glory.

Alexandrite's ambiguity emphasizes one more of its name – "widow stone". During the world wars, many women in Russia had jewelry with this mineral, and not all of their husbands came back from the front. However, if the spouses are nearby, alexandrite can prolong their union. That's why the 45th anniversary of the wedding is called "alexandrite".

The second country in which the stone was popular among the nobility was India. Here people believe that alexandrite can work only for strong-minded rulers who can subordinate the stone to their mood.

Alexandrite in lithotherapy

Alexandrite magical properties reflect its physical characteristics. So, Eliphas Levi argued that the ability of a stone to change color connects it with human blood, which can also be bright red and bluish-brown. Lithotherapists use alexandrite for purification and strengthening of blood vessels, normalization of hematopoiesis, treatment of varicose veins and prevention of cardiac pathologies. In addition, alexandrite:

- Normalizes the work of the gastrointestinal tract and glands liver, spleen, pancreas;
- Strengthens immunity, heals scabies and leprosy;
- Favorably affects the nervous and endocrine systems, improving the psycho-emotional state;
- Helps to cope with alcoholism, drug addiction.

Experts recommend to carefully handle the mineral and remove the products from it before going to bed.

Amber is a mascot-gemstone of the 10 lunar day, time to strengthen the family ties, create and maintain traditions. This means that amber gets the greatest power on the 10th day after New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Amber in the history of different countries

Amber magical properties are known to mankind from the 10th century BC, as evidenced by the Assyrian cuneiform.

In Egypt people made censers from amber, in the Russian Empire – the priests' sticks. The ancients believed that amber powder cures fever, problems with the stomach, eyesight, teeth.

Amber in lithotherapy

Amber magical properties are actively used in medicine to this day. So, in any pharmacy today you can find amber acid. It is the biostimulator, which contributes to the productive work of the brain. In addition, amber:

- Is useful for people who control their weight, as it speeds up the metabolism and excretion of toxins from the body;
- Reduces the risk of developing lung cancer and negative effects of nicotine on the body of smokers (in the form of a mouthpiece);
- Heals colds, bronchitis, chronic cough and asthma (in the form of powder and smoke from its burning);
- Normalizes the work of the thyroid gland;
- Helps pregnant and nursing mothers to give birth and raise a healthy baby.

Only one look at amber raises the mood and warms the soul! This mineral has a beautiful, calm, warm and positive energetics. Amber magical properties tie to its key characteristics. So, this stone:

- Protects the house from natural disasters, assaults of hooligans and thefts;
- Extends youth, gives vivacity and joy.

Amber is a wonderful transmitter of love and happiness from generation to generation. That's why pregnant and breastfeeding women should wear it. In addition, this crystal is able to capture and preserve the memory of many generations of the family. Hence its second name – "the tears of eternity".

Carnelian - flesh and blood

The name "carnelian" speaks for itself ("carnis" – the flesh). This reddish stone reminds us of human flesh and blood. However, there is another key similarity between stone and human. Scientists have noticed that the natural radioactivity of carnelian is equal to the radioactivity of the human body.

This feature of the stone allows us to heal many diseases, restore the balance of energy in the body.

Carnelian is a mascot-gemstone of the 11 lunar day, the period when the powerful energy of Kundalini awakens in our body. This means that carnelian gets the greatest power on the 11th day after New Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Carnelian in the history of different countries

Carnelian magical properties were known to people much earlier than the concept of "radioactivity". Thus, in India people worshiped carnelian, as a stone-teacher, contributing to spiritual development. The Egyptians considered this mineral to be nothing else than the frozen energy of the Sun. The Romans made statues of rulers and gods from this stone.

- Reduces tooth pain.

How to work with carnelian

In order to use carnelian magical properties as efficiently as possible, follow the rules. Firstly, remove the stone from your body periodically. Especially in times of too intense purification (nausea, diarrhea, rhinitis).

Secondly, arrange the first contact with carnelian on the Growing Moon in the 2nd quarter. The radioactive balance of human during this period contributes to the most productive work of the stone.

If you want a rapid impact of carnelian on the body, choose jewelry with golden framing. If you need a gradual improvement process, give preference to silver.

Remember: carnelian stones with white veins have the greatest healing power. And, of course, treat the mineral with respect and sincerely thank him for any help.

The Iranian kings constructed canopies for their thrones from this bright mineral. With its help, even strangers will want to give you support. At the same time, when the mineral end its job and life enters a favorable course, it is better to postpone jacinth.

Agate - the Creator's Eye

Agate is a common mineral on our planet, which has many varieties. The cut of a layered stone is similar to the eye – in part, therefore it is called "The Creator's Eye".

According to legend, the Creator, turning into a white eagle, fought with an evil sorcerer. During the battle, his eye fell to the ground, and after a time it petrified. Since then, agate lives among people. Its mission is to distinguish good deeds from evil ones.

Maybe, that is why opal is a mascot-gemstone of the 18 lunar day. It is the time of acceptance our negative traits and the work on their correction. This means that opal gets the greatest power on the third day after Full Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Opal in different cultures

The Australian Aborigines believed that once upon a time God came down on a rainbow. His feet touched the earth, and sparkling opals were born in that place. In the East people have long used opal to preserve marital happiness. In Ancient Rome with the help of this mineral people

defended against epidemics and natural disasters. When opals came to Europe at the beginning of the 19th century, they immediately gained immense popularity among sorcerers and magicians.

Opal in lithotherapy

The rules of work with opal

Opal is a fragile stone in all senses and requires a special approach to itself. First, you should not give or receive opal as a gift. It is better to buy it for yourself.

Second, opal should not be worn constantly. Let the stone rest from time to time.

Third, remember that the rim of gold enhances opal magical properties.

Labradorite - the connection with space

All the stories about labradorite contain mention of the mysterious Hyperborea. Its inhabitants were the first people who appreciated the mineral properly and actively used its magical abilities.

The stone gained its name much later, in honor of the peninsula, on which it was first discovered by Europeans. At the end of the 18th century, labradorite gained popularity in jewelry in Paris and London.

Interestingly, around the same time, Russians found deposits of labradorite – during the erection of the Hermitage. The nobility and ruling elite immediately fell in love with the unusual stone.

This means that the jasper acquires the greatest strength on the fifth day after the Full Moon, and all the rituals with it will pass more effectively at this particular time.

Jasper in the history of different countries

The magical properties of jasper known to mankind for more than a hundred thousand years. So, the Greeks used jasper pendants in order to protect themselves from the evil eye, to help women in labor to give life to a healthy baby. The Romans carved their own names on pieces of jasper and carried them everywhere. It was believed that such an amulet protects the host from diseases and epidemics.

In the East and in ancient Egypt, jasper was considered a symbol of beauty, youth and prosperity. Healers Hippocrates and Avicenna used this stone to treat epilepsy, fever, and stomach ailments. - Diseases of the kidneys, bladder, stomach, gastrointestinal disorders and poisoning;
- Stuttering and epilepsy;
- Toothache;
- Gynecological diseases, infertility, toxemia, bleeding red jasper;
- They cleanse the body of toxins, rejuvenate the body.

Jasper energetics and its impact on humans

The spectrum of the mystical influence of jasper on a person is as wide as the range of colors of a motley stone. The magical properties of jasper of different colors agree on one thing - the mineral always has a positive effect on humans.

At the same time, *red* jasper helps to attract the attention of the opposite sex, building a successful career. Helps colleagues to improve relationships in the working team.

Black jasper gives the owner wisdom, resourcefulness, willpower, nobility. Dark stones are the best guardian against negative influences from the outside, both for an individual and for the whole family and home.

Brown jasper helps to cope with fears, improves concentration. This stone is recommended for schoolchildren, students, scientists.

Green jasper helps to cope with stress and nervous exhaustion, and multi-colored promotes successful meditations.

Rules for working with jasper

Jasper is the perfect talisman for any sign of the zodiac. At the same time, the fire signs should use orange, red jasper; water - gray; the earth is green and brown; air - yellow and white.

If you want to increase your wealth, store jewelry and money in a jasper box. To protect loved ones, put their photos in a frame of motley stone.

It is noteworthy that the magical properties of jasper manifest themselves especially strongly when the stone is framed in silver.

Aventurine - the stone of risk and love

Aventurine is one of many varieties of quartz with bright impregnations of other minerals that give a golden gleam to the stone. Known as the guardian of love and bringing prosperity.

It is aventurine – mascot-gemstone of the 21 lunar day, a period of creativity, creative reflection and effective movement forward. This means that the greatest strength aventurine finds on day 6 after the Full Moon, and all the rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Aventurine in different cultures

It is believed that the name aventurine came from the old Italian «avennture», which translates as «adventure», «happiness». Italian navigators believed that the mineral would help them return home unharmed and take it on a voyage.

It is interesting that aventurine became popular long before that. Gem to Europe fell due to the Indian traders of precious stones, around the 15th and 16th century. The mineral was used to make women's jewelry, as well as various vases, figurines, candlesticks, cutlery.

Today, aventurine is popular all over the world. Its small deposits are located in India, Germany, South Africa and the United States.

Aventurine in lithotherapy

The magical properties of aventurine are used by lithotherapists to treat emotional wounds and nervous disorders, as:

In the treatment and prevention of using a variety of forms of massagers, jewelry from this stone (preferably in the form of beads on the neck or wrist).

There are many varieties of aventurine: green, cherry, honey, it is also found black.

So to achieve success in new endeavors, astrologers are advised to wear a ring with a *yellow* stone on the 21 day of the lunar cycle.

Red the mineral will provide you with the necessary energy boost, will awaken in your owner intelligence, which will help to solve any difficult situation.

Green aventurine, which is known as Indian jade, is associated with the heart chakra and protects loving people, contributes to the well-being of the family hearth. His magical qualities also drive away spoilage, evil eyes, hatred and envy.

Blue minerals protect against trouble on long journeys.

Black gems help you find your vocation and realize yourself in business by revealing the human subconscious.

It is important to remember that any aventurine is not recommended for long periods of time since it can change its energy from time to time. Therefore, the stone must be cleaned and discharged 1-2 times per month under running water. Then fill it with strength and positive energy, putting it under the sun's rays.

Sapphire - the symbol of the heavenly dome

Sapphire is a kind of mineral corundum, which in turn can have many shades (only bright red corundum is called ruby). Therefore, although speaking of sapphire, the stone is most often represented as a transparent gem of a bright blue color. However, they can be pink, yellow, green,

red-orange, violet and colorless. For example, the sapphires of the Urals and the USA are gray-blue, and Australian and African stones have dichroism: along the elongation of the crystals they are dark blue, and across the green.

Sapphire is a mascot-gemstone of the 22 lunar day, the period of rest, the knowledge of oneself and the introduction of light into all spheres of life. This means that the sapphire obtains the greatest strength on day 7 after the Full Moon, and all rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Sapphire in the history of different countries

The name «sapphire» comes from the ancient Indian word «canipriya» – beloved by Saturn. Therefore, the priests of the temple of Jupite constantly wore sapphires in the ring of the color of a cornflower. Also, this gem was adorned with clothes by priests in Judea, India.

In ancient times, sapphires were inlaid with goblets since it was believed that the stone could recognize the poison by changing its color, and it was also used as an antidote.

They also believed that he could even soften God's wrath because sapphire is famous for transmitting the prayers of believers to heaven.

The precious mineral shone in the crown of Cleopatra. It is believed that the blue color of sapphire and its energy field calms down, relieve the excitement, the raging passions are quelled. It is not surprising that the stone became a talisman of philosophers, scientists and poets.

It was believed that the strength of the mineral helps a woman to attract the attention of her lover. Long ago, a ring with sapphire as an engagement sign was the dream of every girl who dreamed of a happy and long marriage. Gold earrings with sapphire were given to a married woman in recognition of her intelligence, earnestness, decency, purity of the soul.

Today, artificial sapphires are produced. Such a stone was first synthesized in the US in the middle of the twentieth century. Since then large-scale extraction of such corundum is being carried out all over the world. The main difference between artificial stones is the absence of natural inclusions, which can be seen only under a microscope.

Sapphire in lithotherapy

Since ancient times, lithotherapists have been using sapphire to treat eye disease. It is believed that he is able to cure leprosy and all sorts of evil growths, acting as an antidote.

Sapphire helps with insomnia, back pain, colds, bronchial asthma, heart disease and even cancer. Has a positive effect on diabetes, kidney disease, lowers blood pressure.

According to Indian Ayurveda, sapphire has a therapeutic effect in neuralgia, epilepsy, can help people prone to hysterics and psychoses.

Wear sapphire around the neck, in a gold frame. It must be remembered that a stone with defects can bring misfortunes (cracks in the mineral indicate an imminent danger).

Sapphire energetics and its impact on humans

Sapphire is a magical stone, giving fidelity and chastity:

- 1. As a talisman gives his master the ability to contemplate, develops clarity of thought, which helps to find a goal in his life, overcome all fears and depressions. Unsure of people gem gives decisiveness and courage.
- 2. Emits the powerful energy of the cosmos. Sapphire strengthens loyalty and prudence in man. It protects from fear and perfidy, excites the concentration and purity of the soul, cools passion. That is why he was called a stone of nuns;
- 3. It ignites the fire of creativity, promotes the awakening of the extraordinary emotional vision and perception of life. He gives clarity to thoughts, stirs up a thirst for knowledge, strengthens memory;
- 4. It is able to pass through itself energy, purify it and give it to a person. So it is used in meditations, and also as talismans for people who are overcome by laziness.

Rauchtopaz - the stone of the Buddha

Rauchtopaz is a kind of quartz. The color of the gem can be of different intensity – from light smoky to brown.

Kerngorm, «Scottish topaz» – some more ancient names of a stone. The first images of smoky transparent quartz in the territory of Western Europe were found in Scotland – in the Kernhorm mountains. Rauhtopaz was worn on their clothes by the Scottish Highlanders.

Maybe, that is why rauchtopaz is a mascot-gemstone of the 23 lunar day. It is the time of correct completion of cases, an understanding of their mistakes. This means that rauchtopaz gets the greatest power on the 8th day after Full Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Rauchtopaz in different cultures

In Tibet and India he called the «stone of the Buddha», believing that he has magical properties.

Ancient Hindus believed that rauchtopaz removes negative energy from the body.

In Russia XVII-XVII centuries rauchtopaz was not very popular because of the dark color and supposed in connection with this «dark» essence. It believed that the stone can become a guide to the other world.

It is this magical meaning of smoky quartz that made it very popular in the XIX century, when the passion for spiritualism became fashionable. Thus, the gem was repeatedly used in rituals with charms and conspiracies, and with its help they made contact with the souls of dead people. Smoky quartz became a talisman of philosophers, healers, mystics, astrologers. But if the owner could not cope with his inner strength, then the stone destroyed it. Rauhtopaz was especially popular with female representatives.

Girls used a stone for the love spells of their chosen ones and for the fullest impact on them.

Today, the main deposits of smoky quartz are in the Swiss Alps, Spain, the United States of America, as well as in Brazil, Namibia and Madagascar.

Rauchtopaz in lithotherapy

Stone is often used to treat:

- Drug addiction;
- Alcohol addiction;
- In the fight against smoking.

Lithotherapists also tell wearing rauchtopaz to people with paranoid and suicidal tendencies. This stone will adjust to positive thoughts, raise self-esteem.

It believed that rauchtopaz affects the reproductive organs. For women, he «helps» conceive a child. In men, it helps restore potency.

Rauchtopaz energetics and its impact on humans

Rauchtopaz considered a stone of tranquility and meditative contemplation.

Helps to remove irritability and anger. Eliminates jealousy and pride, which is important for health. To do this, clamp the gem in your hand. Imagine how a stone sucks negative and anxiety out of you. Squeeze your hands when you feel that it has warmed.

According to our ancestors, water (in a bowl made from rauchtopaz) removes slag treats most of the serious diseases.

Smoke crystal also immerses its owner in a world of illusions and helps to survive difficult situations. But this stone is not for every day. Decoration is necessary only in those days when you want to forget yourself.

Other magical properties – the ability to attract prophetic dreams.

The darker the stone, the more energy accumulated in it. So young female representatives should choose a light mineral.

Obsidian - volcanic glass

The non-crystallized lava of volcanic origin is obsidian. By its name this stone is due to the warrior of Rome Obsidius. As the legend says, Obsidius brought this stone to Rome, although in other parts of the world it was already quite famous.

In the literature, you can find a huge number of names of mineral (mountain mahogany, muslin and resin stone, «tears of Apache», «fragments of the bones of Satan»).

Maybe, that is why obsidian is a mascot-gemstone of the 24 lunar day. It is the period of the destruction of the old and the creation of a new. This means that obsidian gets the greatest power on the 9th day after Full Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Obsidian in different cultures

Obsidian is one of the most powerful stones, protecting a person from negative external influences. Thus, for example, in Transcaucasia used it as a children's amulet since time immemorial.

The ancient inhabitants of America and Ethiopia produced obsidian mirrors. Often, ancient peoples used knives from obsidian on their ritual sacrifices and embalming.

The Egyptians stored the incense inside the obsidian vessels. Thanks to this, the substance retained its properties.

Later, the stone used in applied, sculptural, jewelry spheres of art. In Russia the most popular connoisseur of stone was Faberge. He used it in his works of famous people all over the world.

Most of the obsidian is now mined in Ecuador, Japan and Ethiopia, places with increased volcanic activity, as well as in the US, Turkey.

Also, obsidian is known for its beneficial effects on the gastrointestinal tract. Jewelry made of stone can normalize blood pressure.

To avoid diseases, you only need to wear obsidian jewelry. But, do not do this too often. Volcanic glass can affect the health status (for example, reduce the energy of the kidneys).

Mineral is useful to wear with neuroses, diseases of the spine, rheumatism. Helps obsidian with gout, diseases of the reproductive system, accelerates the healing process of the skin.

Obsidian energetics and its impact on humans

It has long believed that obsidian helps to transfer even the most difficult tests. A stone can use as a strong amulet. He is able to create a barrier to destructive emotions, reflects mental attacks from the outside.

Also, obsidian stimulates people who lack initiative, they charge them with energy and desire to change their lives. But to update the protective talisman, it must be regularly cleaned!

The magical properties of the mineral by colors:

Tiger's eye - the stone of fulfilled desires

The tiger's eye is one of the varieties of quartz with a characteristic golden brownish outflow. The mineral has several relatives:

«Bull's eye» is a stone with red patches and shades;

«Cat's eye» - quartz with dark wavy pictures

«Falcon eye» - a gem with a blue light

«Zebra stone» is a mineral with a strip of dark-brown strips.

Maybe, that is why tiger's eye is a mascot-gemstone of the 25 lunar day. It is the period of emptiness after the achievement of the task, the restoration of forces. This means that obsidian gets the greatest power on the 10th day after Full Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Tiger's eye in different cultures

In Ancient Rome warriors wore an amulet with a tiger's eye. The stone protected lives and gave courage in battle. It is the ancient Roman warriors who began to wear the mineral first.

In Egypt believed that the solar energy of the god Ra concentrated in the quartz. The inhabitants used an amulet from the tiger's eye to protect children.

Jade - national stone of the Celestial Empire

Jade in translation from the Greek «lapis nephriticus» means «kidney stone». This is how it was long called in European countries, but later it got its modern name.

Jade differs in color, which depends on the content of various impurities in it. More common is a green mineral. The most valuable stones are red and blue jade. A gem with the effect of «tiger's eye» considered unique.

Maybe, that is why jade is a mascot-gemstone of the 26 lunar day. It is the period of following natural rhythms. This means that jade gets the greatest power on the 11th day after Full Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Jade in different cultures

The stone became famous one thousand years ago! In ancient times, jade valued in almost all corners of the earth.

The Aztecs put dead gems in their mouths, hoping for their early resurrection. From it created magic masks, which helped to communicate with spirits.

It was this mineral that became the national stone of China. Jade for the Chinese was the stone of Heaven, Earth, Wisdom, Eternity, Immortality. They decorated with palaces and imperial tombs. All cult temple complexes in China are full of sculptures from this gem. In the famous Temple of the Jade Buddha there are still preserved 2 huge sculptures of the Buddha. Jade in lithotherapy

Lithotherapists apply the mineral to the area of the stomach or near the kidneys. Nephrite acts as a prolonged warming compress and relieves pain.

The stone normalizes the pressure, improves the work of the lungs and heart. It prevents hair from drying out, strengthens the liver, stomach, heart.

Massage with nephritis stimulates and helps blood circulation in the brain, removes fatigue. Such massage rollers used to relieve headache, for cosmetic facial massage.

Currently, more often use jade cushions – an ancient Chinese remedy.

Wash the mineral in soapy water. It is enough to wipe the stone with a damp soft cloth. Keep jade products better in individual cases.

Selenite in different cultures

In Ancient Egypt selenite powder used to maintain the elasticity of the body.

In Tibet, stones extracted from the gallbladder with the help of a mineral.

In India amulets of selenite used for spiritual purification and emotional relief. Hindus believe that the stone improves memory and develops the gift of eloquence.

Selenite is one of the few minerals that clergymen use. They do not deny its effectiveness, nor do they reckon with the gifts of the devil. The mineral gives them providence and develops intuition. Selenite amulets pilgrims took with them to their wanderings.

The seven elephants are the popular embodiment of home well-being in Eurasia. In Russia of the last century it made from Ural selenite (not porcelain (as in China), ivory (as in Japan) or marble (as in Italy)).

Selenite in lithotherapy

Lithotherapists have a very popular mineral. The magical properties of selenite allow it:

- Speed up wound healing and post-traumatic edema;
- Increase elasticity of ligaments and joint mobility;
- Normalize the functioning of the stomach and intestines;
- Making teeth and bones stronger;

It is important to remember that selenite requires special storage conditions. This is a special temperature regime and a special humidity. Maybe, that is why chrysoprase is a mascot-gemstone of the 28 lunar day. It is the period of increased load. This means that chrysoprase gets the greatest power on the 13th day after Full Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Chrysoprase in different cultures

The popularity of jewelry with chrysoprase is unequal in different periods of time. They appreciated in the Ancient World – Egypt, Greece, Rome.

On the East believed that in the hands of false people chrysoprase very darkens. Honest people mineral warned of imminent danger of turbidity. Indian magicians believed that the gem protects against envy, evil eye, spoilage.

In medieval Europe chrysoprase considered a symbol of success, luck and friendship, a stone. Gem used as an amulet, which protects from negative energy. The stone became a talisman, protecting from dangers and attracting good people.

The next wave of popularity of products with mineral rose in the middle of the XVIII century and has not weakened until now.

The main fields located in Australia.

Chrysoprase in lithotherapy

Lithotherapists use stone for pains in the throat and ears, asthma attacks and with other ailments the respiratory system.

The sheer positive effect of the mineral on the function of the thyroid gland and the organs of vision.

According to lithotherapists, chrysoprase facilitates the patient's condition in infections and various inflammations.

It also helps to treat depression and smooths the manifestations of menopause.

The main method of applying chrysoprase is wearing jewelry with it. But folk healers do not recommend the use of stone on a permanent basis for medicinal purposes. Prolonged contact with the mineral can affect the health status. May cause the formation of stones in the gallbladder.

A stone can be charged with water. To do this, a piece of chrysoprase dropped into the liquid container and kept in sunlight for 4-5 hours. You can use such water as a medicine for non-infectious colds.

Chrysoprase considered a stone of innovators. Favorable for any new business. It is also the best mascot for business people who work with large sums of money. But it does not work well for a person who likes to over-exert risk.

Thanks to chrysoprase, a person can overcome fears, overcome difficult situations.

The stone will save you from accidents, injuries, unforeseen circumstances.

Gem helps to cope with grievances, distrust towards friends or close people. The stone helps to stop anger, to cool emotions. He brings peace and complete peace into the soul of his master.

The magical properties of the gem will have their positive effect only if the stone is in the hands of an honest, kind person. If the person is evil, capable of despicable deeds, then chrysoprase will not help him.

Pearl - ocean's gift

Pearls can be considered as the gift of the sea and its marine inhabitants. To make a pearl out of a grain of sand that has fallen into the shell of a mollusk, it takes more than one year. And for larger stones – a dozen years. When the marine body enters the body, a protective reaction triggered. He pinches the pea with a mother-of-pearl. This is how an unusual gem formed.

The color of the pearl depends on its place of extraction:

- Near the Indian coast it is tender pink,
- In Sri Lanka, only yellow shades;
- In Austria and Japan, you can get a mineral of snow-white tones
- Golden pearls on the beaches of Panama.

Maybe, that is why pearl is a mascot-gemstone of the 29 lunar day. It is the period of transformation. This means that pearl gets the greatest power on the 14th day after Full Moon, and any rituals with it will be more effective at this time.

Pearl in different cultures

Indian legend says that the gem grew in the toad's head. In others, the mineral formed in the clouds and, falling into the sea, got into the sink.

The Philippines believed that with the sun rising over the sea, the sun's rays fell into the pearls. So the pearl formed.

Russian legends say that the gem brings only the best to the person. He keeps his youth and has a beneficial effect on his health.

In China pearls are the stagnant beginning of Yin. So, it can prolong life and youth.

Roman emperors decorated their robes with pearls.

Ancient shells found in the Arabian Gulf, on the shores of the Red Sea. The oldest pearl from the Persian Gulf. She is 4,000 years old.

In Islamic and Christian religions it believed that pearls are a symbol of purity and perfection.
